

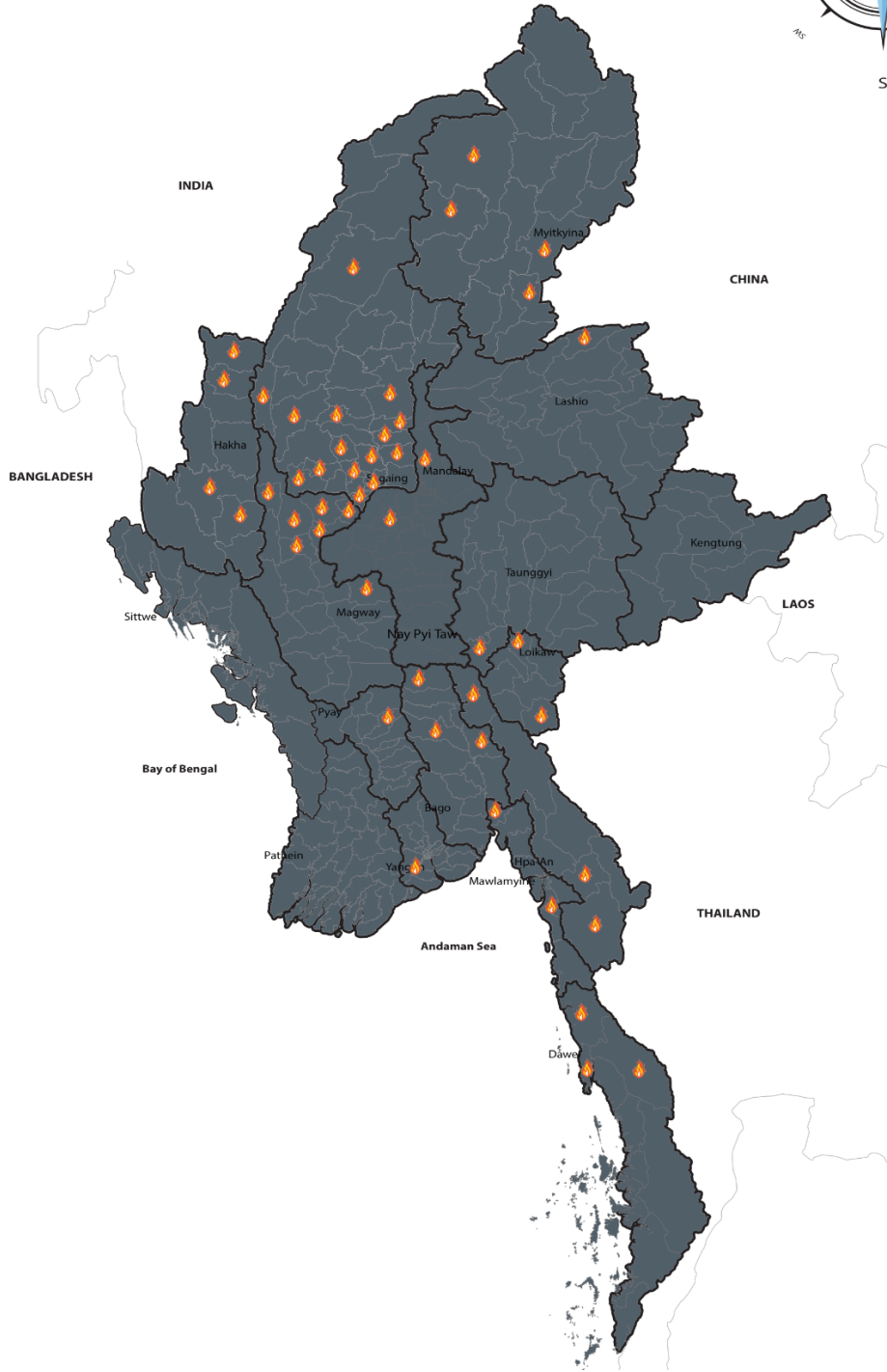
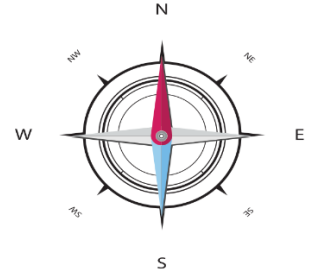

### **July 8, 2023**

#### **Strikes**

Locals hold boycotts of the SAC's 2023 elections in the following places: Yinmarbin-Salingyi township, the northside of Yinmarbin, and Latpataung hill in the Sagaing region; Kyangin township, Ayeyarwady region; Yangon region.

#### **Election Updates**

Nothing to report.

#### **Military Clashes**

15 SAC soldiers were killed and another 10 injured in a clash between KIA and SAC forces in Tanai township, Kachin State.

There was a clash between KIA and SAC forces in Dot Phone Yan town, Momauk township, Kachin State.

Seven SAC soldiers were killed and another 12 injured by in a mine attack organized by PDFs along Shwebo-Kyaukmyauing road in Shwebo township, Sagaing region.

#### **Human Rights Violations**

The Junta army conducted an airstrike on Mindat township in southern Chin State. The bombing killed two women and a nine-year old girl and wounded a 50-year-old man.

Two civilians were killed when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Kyaukkyi township, Bago region.

One civilian was burned to death and another civilian arrested by SAC forces in Mya Kan village, Khin-U township, Sagaing region.

One child and two civilians were killed when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Ywar Thar Ywar, Yaza Kyaw, and Pyan Hlae villages in Yinmarbin township, Sagaing region.

One child and three civilians were killed by SAC forces in Na Bal Kyu village, Myinmu township, Sagaing region.

### **July 9, 2023**

#### **Strikes**

Locals held protests against the SAC's 2023 elections in the following places: Yinmarbin-Salingyi township, the northside of Yinmarbin, Taze township, and Latpataung hill in the Sagaing region; Launglon township, Tanintharyi region; Myaing township, Magway region; Kyangin township, Ayeyarwady region.

#### **Election Updates**

#### **Military Clashes**

Four SAC soldiers were killed and another five injured in a clash with CDFs in Lai Lin Pi Town, Matupi township, Chin State.

One SAC soldier was killed when PDFs fired aerial bombs and rockets at the Kyauk Rait police station in Myaung township, Sagaing region.

Four SAC militias were killed in a clash with PDFs near Si Sone Lay village in Khin-U township, Sagaing region.

There was a clash between PDF and SAC forces in Inn Ma Htee village, Pale township, Sagaing region.

Six SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with CNA forces near Thida village, Hakha township, Chin State.

Two SAC militias were killed when PDFs attacked the immigration office in Yedashe township, Bago region.

There was a clash between KIA and SAC forces near Nan San Yan village, Waingmaw township, Kachin State.

There was a clash between PDF and SAC forces in Chi village, Sitoktaya township, Magway region.

One SAC soldier was killed in a mine attack organized by PDFs near Thapyay Pin village, Budalin township, Sagaing region.

One SAC soldier was killed in a clash with PDFs in Kyet Pyin village, Madaya township, Mandalay region.

17 SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs in Nan Za village, Kyauktaga township, Bago region.

### **Human Rights Violations**

More than 20 civilians were arrested and six houses burned down by SAC forces in Kyauk Ohe village, Natmauk township, Magway region.

More than 180 houses were burned down when SAC forces set fires in Gone Hyin Sate village, Myinmu township, Sagaing region.

## **July 10, 2023**

### **Strikes**

Locals boycott the SAC's 2023 elections in Kyangin township, Ayeyarwady region and Yinmarbin-Salingyi township, Sagaing region.

### **Military Clashes**

Two SAC soldiers were killed by snipers when they were on ambush patrol in Pal Khin Gyi village, Natogyi township, Mandalay region.

One SAC soldier was killed in a clash with PDFs in Si Pie village, Yedashe township, Bago region.

There was a clash between PDF and SAC forces in Inn village, Mingin township, Sagaing region.

Two SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs at the SAC camp in Myaing township, Magway region.

### **Human Rights Violations**

One civilian was killed and 17 civilians were arrested by SAC forces in Kyaukkyi township, Bago region.

SAC jet fighters fired at Ye Myet village in Ye-U township, Sagaing region.

Two civilians were killed by SAC forces from Pyar Sakhan village, Thandaunggyi township, Kayin State.

Five civilians were killed by SAC forces in Sha Du Zout village, Tanai township, Kachin State.

One civilian was killed when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Ma Eu village, Monywa township, Sagaing region.

## **July 11, 2023**

### **Strikes**

Locals boycott the SAC's 2023 elections in Yinmarbin-Salingyi township, Sagaing region and Myaing township, Magway region.

### **Military Clashes**

There was a clash between PDF and SAC forces in Tie Ngain village, Tedim township, Chin State.

One child and one civilian were killed in a clash between PDF and SAC forces along Loikaw-Pekon road in Loikaw township, Kayah (Karenni) State.

10 SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs at the police station and bridge in Oke Twin village, Phyu township, Bago region.

Five SAC soldiers were killed in a mine attack organized by PDFs near Chaung Ma Gyi village, Madaya township, Mandalay region.

There was a clash between PDFs and SAC forces at the SAC camp in Ywar Do village, Thandaunggyi township, Kayin State.

There was a clash between TNLA and SAC forces near Nant Taung village in Muse township, northern Shan State.

### **Human Rights Violations**

Unprovoked, SAC military troops burned Ma Eu village in Monywa township, Sagaing region.

Three civilians were killed and 100 houses burned down by SAC forces from Ma Lal Thar, Nyaung Pin, and Kan Yin villages in Ayadaw township, Sagaing region.

One civilian was killed when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Taung Phi Lar and Gyo Thone Pin wards in Kale township, Sagaing region.

14 Houses were burned down by SAC forces in Kwan Chan and Taw Tel villages in Monywa township, Sagaing region.

## **July 12, 2023**

### **Strikes**

Locals held boycotts against the SAC's 2023 elections in the following places: the northside of Yinmarbin, Yinmarbin-Salingyi township, Latpataung hill, and Yinmarbin township in the Sagaing region; Kyangin township, Ayeyarwady region; Launglon township, Tanintharyi region; Myaing township, Magway region.

## **Military Clashes**

28 SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs in Ywar Thit village, Pauk township, Magway region.

One SAC soldier was killed in a drone attack organized by PDFs in Taung Kan Ni village, Myaing township, Magway region.

One SAC soldier was killed and another 9 injured when PDFs fired mortar bombs at the Northwestern Regional Military Headquarters in Alon town, Monywa township, Sagaing region.

Four SAC soldiers were killed in a mine attack organized by PDFs at the palace in Shwebo township, Sagaing region.

## **Human Rights Violations**

One child was killed when SAC fighter jets fired at Kyauk Su village in Mese township, Kayah (Karenni) State.

SAC fighter jets fired at Lay Htaung, Myay Kyet Su, and Myoe Gyi villages in Yinmarbin township, Sagaing region.

One civilian was killed and another two injured when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Thet Tu village, Shwebo township, Sagaing region.

Three civilians were killed when SAC fighter jets fired at the Daw Noe Ku war camp in Loikaw township, Kayah (Karenni) State.

More than 10 houses were burned down by SAC forces in Wah Yone Kone village, Khin-U township, Sagaing region.

## **July 13, 2023**

### **Strikes**

Locals held boycotts against the SAC's 2023 elections in the following places: Yinmarbin-Salingyi township, the eastside of Yinmarbin, and Latpataung hill in the Sagaing region; Kyangin township, Ayeyarwady region.

Locals held protests against the SAC's 2023 elections and held sanctions against MOGE in the northside of Yinmarbin, Sagaing region.

## **Military Clashes**

About 30 SAC soldiers were killed when PDFs ambushed a military column that set fire to villages in Myinmu. The soldiers were ambushed in Hkwat Hkwin village, Myinmu township, Sagaing region.

One SAC soldier was killed in a clash with PDFs at a school in Tonzang township, Chin State.

Two PDF soldiers were killed and another two injured in a clash with SAC forces at Lay village and Ywar Htaung village in Yinmarbin township, Sagaing region.

Three SAC soldiers were killed and another two civilians were killed in a clash with PDFs near Zahar village, Dawei township, Tanintharyi region.

Three SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs at the SAC's camp in Aung Mingalar ward, Khin-U township, Sagaing region.

40 SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with KIA forces at the Nan San Yan Area in Waingmaw township, Kachin State.

One civilian was killed in a clash between KIA and SAC forces near Kamaing town, Hpakan township, Kachin State.

Two SAC soldiers were killed in a drone attack organized by PDFs on the Taung Kya Inn police station and school in Kawkareik township, Kayin State.

## **Human Rights Violations**

One child was killed and another child was injured when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Kha Maung Taung village in Launglon township, Tanintharyi region.

100 Houses were burned down and one civilian was killed when SAC forces set fires in Thone Sint Kan village, Wetlet township, Sagaing region.

35 Houses were burned down by SAC forces in Phalan O village, Pakokku township, Magway region.

41 Houses were burned down and one civilian killed when SAC forces attacked and set fires in Myoe Gyi village in Yinmarbin township, Sagaing region.

More than 12 houses were burned down by SAC forces in Pauk Kan village, Wetlet township, Sagaing region.

### **July 14, 2023**

#### **Strikes**

Locals held boycotts of the SAC's 2023 elections in the following places: Yinmarbin-Salingyi township, Latpataung hill, the northside of Yinmarbin, and Yinmarbin township in the Sagaing region; Kyangin township, Ayeyarwady region.

#### **Election Updates**

Nothing to report.

#### **Military Clashes**

Two SAC soldiers were killed when CDFs of Mindat attacked two SAC checkpoint gates in Mindat town, Chin State.

Four SAC soldiers were injured by a mine attack organized by PDFs between Sin Ma Ye and Sin Chung villages in Yesagyo township, Magway region.

One SAC soldier was killed in a clash with PDFs near Koe Saung gate in Myaing township, Magway region.

One SAC police member was killed in a clash with PDFs at the Kanma police station in Pakokku township, Magway region.

Four SAC soldiers were killed by a mine attack organized by PDFs near Kone Sone village, Pekon township, southern Shan State.

There was a clash between PDFs and SAC forces on Nyein Chan Myaing hill in Kyainseikgyi township, Kayin State.

#### **Human Rights Violations**

A married couple from Sie San village was killed and their 3-year-old child was injured when the SAC military fired heavy weapons in Kale township, Sagaing region.

SAC forces burned down the whole Yin Kae village in Laung Shay town, Saw township, Magway region.

SAC forces burned down Nyaung Pin Ywar Ma village in Kanbalu township, Sagaing region.

Seven civilians were arrested by SAC forces from Letpadan township, Bago region.

SAC forces burned down Htan Gyi and Khat Kha villages in Wetlet township, Sagaing region.

### **Political and International Events**

On July 9, Thailand's Foreign Minister Mr. Don Prahmudwinai met with Daw Aung San Suu Kyi before the ASEAN Foreign Ministers' Meeting in Indonesia. He made the announcement that contradicted Daw Aung San Suu Kyi's opinion on the opening day of the ASEAN meeting held in Jakarta.
