

Locals hold boycotts against the SAC's 2023 elections in the following places: the northside of Yinmarbin, Latpataung Hill, and Yinmarbin township in the Sagaing region; Myaing township, Magway region.

Military Clashes

Two PDF soldiers were killed in a clash with SAC forces in Chat Thin San Pya village, Kanbalu township, Sagaing region.

Two SAC soldiers were killed and another three injured in a clash with PDFs at the SAC's camp at Inpin village, Pakokku township, Magway region.

More than two SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs in Myaing township, Magway region.

Human Rights Violations

One child and five civilians were killed by SAC forces in Ye Su Kan village, Monywa township, Sagaing region.

50 Civilians were arrested by SAc forces at some villages in Salingyi township, Sagaing region.

SAC forces burned down Pa Du village in Sagaing township, Sagaing region.

Four civilians were arrested by SAC forces from Sagaing township, Sagaing region.

Seven civilians were arrested by SAC forces from Tanintharyi township, Tanintharyi region.

Two civilians were killed when SAC forces burned down Doe Pin village in Katha township, Sagaing region.

Strikes

Locals hold boycotts against the SAC's 2023 elections in the following places: Salingyi township, Yinmarbin township, Monywa township, the northside of Yinmarbin, Latpataung hill, and Kani township in the Sagaing region; Launglon township, Tanintharyi region; Kyangin township, Ayeyarwady region.

Military Clashes

Seven SAC policemen were killed, including the station commander, when PDFs organized a drone attack and dropped 15 bombs on Nyaung Pinwun police station in Sagaing township, Sagaing region.

Two SAC soldiers were killed in a drone attack organized by PDFs on the police station and general office in Kani township, Sagaing region.

Nine SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs near Lal Naught village, Yinmarbin township, Sagaing region.

Two SAC soldiers were killed by a bomb attack organized by PDFs on the SAC's camp near the city police station in Myinmu townsihp, Sagaing region.

One SAC soldier was killed and another two injured in a clash with PDFs near Ra Rein Ma village, Myaung township, Sagaing region.

There was a clash between PDFs and SAc forces near Kyee Kan villgae in Khin-U township, Sagaing region.

Eight SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs between Chi Par and Mel Taw village, Shwebo township, Sagaing region.

Human Rights Violations

SAC forces fired from a helicoptor on Nyaung Pin Gyi village in Salingyi township, Sagaing region.

Three civilians were arrested by SAC forces from Hmaw Taung village, Hpakan township, Kachin State.

Two civilians were arrested by SAC froces from Hlaing township, Yangon region.

One civilian was killed when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Nhait Karain village, Ye Twonship, Mon state.

One civilian was killed and another two civilians were arrested by SAC forces in Hmaw Kaung village, Hpakan township, Kachin State.

One civilian was arrested by SAC forces from Ka Lain Aung town in Yebyu township, Tanintharyi region.

Two civilians were killed by SAC froces in Moe Byel town, Pekon township, Southern Shan State.

Military Clashes

Two PDF soldiers were killed in a clash with SAC forces in Moe Byel town, Pekon township, Southern Shan State.

10 SAC militia soldiers were killed and one PDF soldier was killed in a clash between the two forces at the SAC militia camp in Yaw and Lal Hla villages, Kanbalu township, Sagaing region.

Human Rights Violations

Three civilians were hit by artilley shells fired by SAC troops in Kamai Kone village, Kawkareik township, Kayin State.

The dead bodies of two young women who were raped by the SAC military and their father were fond in Moe Byel town, Pekon township, Southern Shan State.

Four civilians were arrested by SAC forces from Au Yin Tal village, Tanintharyi township, Tanintharyi region.

A 52-year-old woman from Inthar village of Lewe township in Nay Pyi Taw territory was arrested by the junta's security forces at 11:20 am.

Four houses were burned down by SAC forces in Ye Aye Kone village, Khin-U township, Sagaing region.

One civilian was killed and another injured when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at the war refugee camp in Ye Lal Oo village, Kale township, Sagaing region.

One civilian was killed when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Nyaung Pin Gyi village, Salingyi township, Sagaing region.

Three houses were burned down by SAC forces in Ka Nat Thiri village, Thayetchaung township, Tanintharyi region.

Military Clashes

15 SAC soldiers were killed and another eight injured by a mine attack ogranized by PDFs near Shwe Mi oil shop along Shwebo-Kyauk Myauing road, Shwebo township, Sagaing region.

Two SAC soldiers were killed and another three injured by a mine attack organized by PDFs along Shwebo-Kyauk Myauing road, Shwebo township, Sagaing region.

Two SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs in Kyi village, Myingyan township, Mandalay region.

Three PDF soldiers were killed in a clash with SAC forces near Taung Nyo Dam, Nattalin township, Bago region.

There was a clash between PDF and SAC forces at the SAC camp in East Bone Kan village, Pakokku township, Magway region.

Human Rights Violations

One monk and two children were killed and another five houses burned down when SAC forces fired mortar bombs near Wah Pin Su village in Kyaukkyi township, Bago region.

One civilian was killed when SAC forces burned down Ya Nge village in Thayetchaung township, Tanintharyi region.

One civilian was killed when SAC forces burned down Bo Tal Kone village, Kanbalu township, Sagaing region.

SAC forces burned down Nyaung Pin Gyi village in Salingyi township, Sagaing region.

June 12, 2023

Strikes

Loclas held boycotts on the SAC's 2023 elections in the following places: the northside of Yinmarbin, Yinmarbin-Salingyi township, Kani township, and Yinmarbin township in the Sagaing region; Kyangin township, Ayeyarwady region; Launglon township, Tanintharyi region.

Military Clashes

At least 20 SAC soldiers were killed on Sunday during an intense clash with joint groups in Moe Byel town, Pekon township, Southern Shan State.

Four SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs in Okpho township, Bago region.

There was a clash between KIA and SAC forces at the SAC camp in Kutkai township, Northern Shan State

Human Rights Violations

Two political prisoners were taken to the police station and shot dead by SAC forces between Gangaw and Pyar village in Gangaw township, Magway region.

One civilian was killed by SAC forces in Pa Dauk Pin village, Kanbalu township, Sagaing region.

14 Civilians were arrested by SAC forces from Sagaing township, Sagaing region.

50 Houses were burned down when SAC forces set fire to two villages in Kanbalu township, Sagaing region.

Four houses were burned down when SAC forces set fire to Nyaung Pin Thar village in Monywa township, Sagaing region.

Political and International Events

Ethnic Kayah armed groups have engaged in years of fighting against the military regime, and today a new political entity, the Karenni State Interim Executive Council (IEC), was formed in hopes of a realizing a better functioning state.

The military council delegation went to see Daw Aung San Suu Kyi in Nay Pyi Taw prison.

June 13, 2023

Strikes

Locals held boycotts against the SAC's 2023 elections in Yinmarbin township, Yinmarbin-Salingyi township, Salingyi township, and the northside of Yinmarbin in the Sagaing region.

Military Clashes

The Student's Revolutionary Force (SRF) launched a surprise attack on the base camp of the junta's Pyu Saw Htee group in Ingyintaung village, Mingin township, Sagaing region. They captured six members of the Pyu Saw Htee group alive and seized their weapons. In total, three SAC militia members were killed and another four were arrested.

Two CNA soldiers were killed in a clash with SAC forces in Hakha township, Chin State.

Three SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs in Tha Htay Kone village, Madaya township, Mandalay region.

Three SAC soldiers were killed and another 13 injured in a clash with PDFs at the SAC's camp (Kwi Lon Tai) in Kyainseikgyi township, Kayin state.

11 SAC militia soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs at the SAC militia's camp in Sin Ma Ye village, Yesagyo township, Magway region.

There was a clash between PDFs and SAC forces at the police station and SAC camp in Mese township, Kayah (Karenni) State.

One SAC soldier was killed and another six injured in a mine attack organized by PDFs near Kyawal Htein Kone village in Tanintharyi township, Tanintharyi region.

Seven SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs at the SAC's camp in Pan Tai Chone village, Pakokku township, Magway region.

There was a clash between PDF and SAC forces near the cement factory in Lewe township, Nay Pyi Taw region.

There was a clash between PDF and SAC forces at the SAC's checkpoint in Mway Houghr Myaung Phaya Kone, Pyinmana township, Nay Pyi Taw region.

Human Rights Violations

More than 50 houses were burned down when SAC forces set fire to Yone Pin village in Sagaing township, Sagaing region.

SAC forces burned the area near Zin village in Kanbalu township, Sagaing region.

Military Clashes

Seven SAC soldiers were killed by a mine attack organized by PDFs on Tu Yin Boe and Thit Yone villages, Myingyan township, Mandalay region.

One SAC soldier was killed and another injured in a clash with PDFs near Talar cave, Shwe Lay Area, Paungde township, Bago region.

Four SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs at the SAC's camp in Han Lin old town, Wetlet township, Sagaing region.

There was a clash between MNDAA's forces and SAC forces in Lashio township, Northern Shan State.

More than five SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs in Zee Phyu Kone village, Pale township, Sagaing region.

Eight SAC soldiers and one PDF member were killed in a clash between the two forces in Tahyet Kwan village, Myaing township, Magway region.

Human Rights Violations

30 Civilians were arrested when SAC troops set fire to Tharzin village in Sataung town, Sagaing township, Sagaing region.

Two PDF members who were setting up mines were killed by an accidental mine explosion in Sagaing township, Sagaing region.

33 Houses were burned down when SAC forces set fire to Kan Thit village in Khin-U township, Sagaing region.

SAC froces burned down Hnin Taw village in Salingyi township, Sagaing region.

Eight civilians were arrested by SAC forces from Tha Byar and Inn Sought villages, Launglon township, tanintharyi region.

15 Houses were burned down when SAC forces set fire twice to Myoe Soe village in Pakokku township, Magway region.
