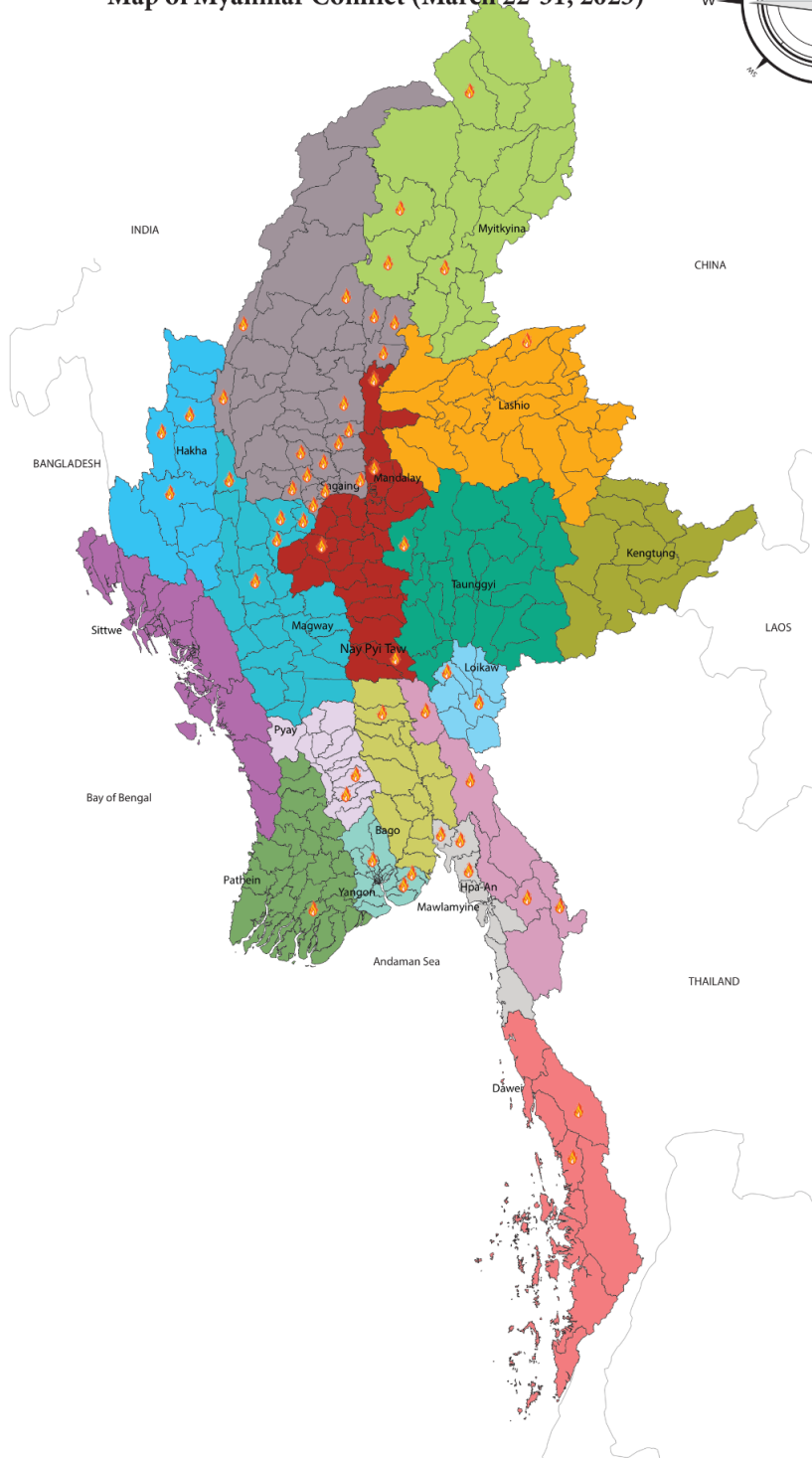
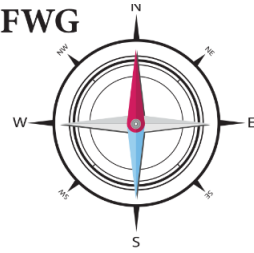

March 22, 2023

Strikes

Locals held demonstrations against the SAC's 2023 elections in Latpataung Hill, Yinmarbin-Salingyi Township, and the northside of Yinmarbin, Sagaing region.

Election Updates

Nothing to report.

Military Clashes

A PDF camp was raided in Htainn Tan Ward, Yesagyo township, Sagaing region and weapons worth about 200,000 Kyats were lost.

There was a clash between PDFs and SAC troops that resulted in three SAC soldiers being killed and houses being set on fire by SAC troops in Po Wa Myaut village, Madaya township, Mandalay region.

More than 10 SAC soldiers were killed in a clash between the KIA, PDF, and SAC forces along Indaw-Katha road, Sagaing region.

Four SAC soldiers were killed in a clash between CNDF and SAC forces in Falam township, Chin state.

One SAC soldier was killed in a clash with PDFs between Gaung Khawe village and Myit Sone village, Myaung township, Sagaing region.

Three SAC soldiers were killed and another three injured in a mine attack organized by PDFS near Pay Kone watergate, Yesagyo township, Magway region.

Five SAC soldiers and one PDF member were killed in a mine attack organized by PDFs near Kaine Taw Ma police station, Myaing township, Magway region.

12 SAC soldiers were killed in a clash between PDFs and SAC forces along Matupi-Paletwa road, Chin state.

Human Rights Violations

The SAC arrested 15 teachers working with the National Unity Government (NUG)'s online schools in Mandalay region. Meanwhile, the NUG and SAC held dueling matriculation exams in March, with 60,000 students taking the NUG exams and 160,000 taking the SAC exams.

The military council organized air strikes on Saw Hti Township and Lal Do Township, KNU Tat Ma Har (3) area. A primary school and five houses were burned down, more than 3,000 civilians were forced to escape, and one civilian was injured.

Two children and 10 civilians were injured when SAC forces fired mortar bombs in Myoe Pauk village, Saw township, Magway region.

One civilian was killed by SAC troops in Kye Badon village, Alone township, Sagaing region.

Four members of PDFs were killed during a military air strike that was fired near Zee Phyu Kone village, Pale township, Sagaing region.

Two women were arrested by SAC troops in Pakokku township, Magway region.

Political and International Events

Acting President of the National Unity Government (NUG) Duwal Shila has said that he acknowledges China's intervention in the Myanmar issue and urges them to do more to prevent indiscriminate killings by the military.

March 23, 2023

Strikes

Local people led demonstrations against the SAC's 2023 elections in Taze township and Latpataung hill, Sagaing region; Launglon township, Tanintharyi region.

Election Updates

Nothing to report.

Military Clashes

One SAC soldier was killed in a clash with PDFs in Kyet Ma Net village, Nattalin township, Bago region.

Two SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs at a school in Kyo Pin Koe village, Okpho township, Bago region.

13 SAC soldiers were killed in a mine attack organized by PDFs between Min Htein and P Waat Hpyarr village, Palaw township, Tanintharyi region.

Three SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs inside No. 1 cotton/fabric factory in Salingyi township, Sagaing region.

Human Rights Violations

Myanmar's junta gave an arrested comrade of a PDF a life sentence on Wednesday at the regime's ruling court in Kawkareik town, Karen state.

The junta announced that 14 members of an anonymous anti-junta resistance group was arrested with weapons and explosive devices in Monywa town, Sagaing region.

Fifteen people were rescued by PDFs amid the raging fighting in villages where people were trapped and kept from fleeing on March 8 in the southern Shan state.

It was reported that an explosion occurred at the Galon PDF Forces camp based in Depaying Township, and the camp burned down, causing a loss of about 3,000,000 kyats.

One old man was killed and another house damaged when SAC forces set fire to Myakan village for a third time in Khin-U township, Sagaing region.

Military troops shot pedestrians with guns close to Inpat station, Khin-U township, Sagaing region.

SAC troops fired mortar bombs at Win Kan Thit village, burning two houses down and sending civilians running in Kyaikto township, Mon state.

Political and International Events

"W" People's Unity Party "W" People's Unity Army (UWSP/UWSA); The National Democratic Alliance Army (NDAA) and the Shan State Progressive Party. The Shan State Army North (SSPP/SSA) visited Nay Pyi Taw and held a meeting with the leaders of the National Unity and Peacemaking Coordination Committee (NSPNC) of the Military Council.

The military council said that around a thousand Rohingya would be readmitted in mid-April

March 24, 2023

Strikes

Locals organize demonstrations against the SAC's 2023 elections. Places include Yinmarbin township, Yinmarbin-Salingyi, Latpataung hill, Taze township, Kale township, Kabulu township in Sagaing region; Hpakan township, Kachin state; Myaing township, Magway region.

Election Updates

As many as 40 political parties have re-registered with the Union Election Commission (UEC) under the Military Council, according to reports from the Military Council Propaganda Mirror newspaper.

The People's Party registered to run in the upcoming elections with the Union Election Commission (UEC).

Military Clashes

Five SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs near Tha Man Tapo village, Yesagyo township, Sagaing region.

Two PDF soldiers were killed and another three injured in a clash with SAC troops, where they had attacked twice with attack helicopters in Kon Taung village, Tamu township, Sagaing region.

There was a drone attack on SAC troops by PDFs near Ta Man Gyi village, Taungtha township, Mandalay region.

There was a mine attack on SAC forces by PDFs between Tone Tin Kan village and Kan Phyu village, Monywa township, Sagaing region.

Six SAC soldiers were killed in a mine attack by PDFs in Monywa Taung Na, Monywa township, Sagaing region.

Two SAC soldiers were killed and another injured when PDFs fired mortar bombs into an SAC camp in Aung Zaya ward, Monywa township, Sagaing region.

There was a drone attack on militias by PDFs near the fire station in Wetlet township, Sagaing region.

Around 10 SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs in Kyainseikgyi township, Kayin state.

15 guns and ammunition were confiscated during a clash between PDFs and SAC forces by Bhukan police station, on the Kale-Tamu road, Sagaing region.

Human Rights Violations

Five civilians were arrested by SAC troops in Man Hel village, Indaw township, Sagaing region.

One civilian was burned and killed and a monk was arrested when Nyaung Zin Gyi village was burned by SAC troops in Kanbalu township, Sagaing region.

Three civilians were killed and five were injured by a bomb dropped during the military airstrike near Wan Bala village, Bawlakhe township, Kayah state.

Chaug South village burned by the SAC's forces in Okpho township, Bago region.

Two people were injured when a truck ran over a mine in Kamar Sai village, Thaton township, Mon state.

Two civilians were arrested by SAC troops in North Okkalapa, Yangon region.

Two villagers were killed and another two injured when a large weapon exploded in Khone Sone village, Lashio township, North Shan State.

Naung Lat Gyi village and Nan Lan villages were set on fire by SAC troops in Shwegu township, Kachin state.

Political and International Events

15 villages in the northern part of Maungdaw Township will be set aside as the Rakhine State for Rohingyas who will be returning home from refugee camps in Bangladesh. State newspapers controlled by the Military Council reported yesterday that 750 plots of land were planned.

March 25, 2023

Strikes

Locals led demonstrations against the SAC's 2023 elections. Places include Kani township, Yinmarbin-Salingyi, the northside of Yinmarbin and Latpataung hill of Sagaing region; and Launglon township of Tanintharyi region.

Election Updates

Nothing to report.

Military Clashes

More than 90 SAC soldiers and five PDF fighters were killed in a clash between PDF and SAC forces in Daw Thama Gyi village, Demoso township, Kayah State.

Six SAC soldiers were killed and five guns and ammunition confiscated during a clash between PDF and SAC forces in Lal Sot Lot BGF camp, in Bilin township, Mon state.

Near the Myawaddy Trade Zone in Myawaddy township, Kayin state, the KNLA and PDF joint forces and the military are fighting fiercely, as the military troops are firing from a helicopter.

PDFs fired mortar bombs at the Aung Zaya Kone - SAC's camp near Pathein-Monywa road, Monywa township, Sagaing region.

Ten police were arrested and ten guns taken when PDFs attacked Kyone Doe police station, Kawkareik township, Kayin state.

There was a bomb attack on SAC forces by PDFs in the commercial bank in Myinmu township, Sagaing region.

Three SAC soldiers were killed in a drone attack on SAC forces by PDFs by the city entry checkpoint in Taungtha township, Mandalay region.

Two SAC soldiers were killed and another three injured when a military group that came to collect electricity bills for Myaung Gyi village was attacked by a mine near the industrial zone in Shwebo township, Sagaing region.

Late during the night on March 24th, public defense joint forces attacked the city police station and a department office in Yebyu township, Tanintharyi region, burning the department office down.

Human Rights Violations

More than 200 houses were burned down and seven old people killed when SAC troops burned down Sone Konen village, Budalin township, Sagaing region.

Two young people were killed by the SAC's forces in Daught Yet village, Bilin township, Mon state.

Three civilians were injured when the SAC's soldiers fired mortar bombs into the two villages in saung Du Lar group, Demoso township, Kayah state.

Over 100 houses were destroyed by heavy weapons and military airstrikes in Demoso township, Kayah State.

Eight public shops and another house burned down when militias set fire a row of buildings in South Monywa township, Sagaing region.

On March 25, the SAC ordered 100 families in MAGwe city to move away from Magwe Air Force Base by May 20. The SAC claimed that the relocation in Magwe city was due to land encroachment; however, the relocation was likely intended to prevent stand-off PDF attacks on air assets using drones, improvised mortars, and rocket-propelled grenades.

Political and International Events

U Tun Min Lat and his wife Daw Win Min Soe, including the three companies under their control, Star Sapphire Group of Companies, Star Sapphire Trading Company Limited and Star Sapphire Group PTE were sanctioned by the United States. The European Union, Canada, and the UK have taken action to sanction the Asia Sun Group, Asia Sun Trading Co. LTD and Cargo Link Petroleum Logistics Co. LTD.

March 26, 2023

Strikes

Local people continued their boycott against the SAC's 2023 election. Places include the Monywa township, Kale township, Latpataung Hill, and Yinmarbin township of the Sagaing region.

The Student Union demonstrated for the dissolution of the military regime and the transition to a new society in the Yangon region.

Election Updates

Nothing to report.

Military Clashes

Two SAC soldiers were killed and another three injured by a drone attack conducted by PDFs in Nan Taung, Palaw township, Tanintharyi region.

Three SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs in Taw Pu village, Monywa township, Sagaing region.

There was a clash between PDFs and SAC forces on Falam - Hakha road, Chin State.

Five SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs in Thein Chaung village, Sar Taung township, Sagaing region.

Eight SAC soldiers were killed and another 17 injured in a clash with PDFs on Thamayoe bridge, between Wetlet - Ayadaw, Sagaing region.

13 SAC soldiers were killed and one CDF fighter injured in a clash and mine attack on SAC forces by CDF forces on Matupi-Paletwa road, Matupi township, Chin State.

14 members of the military council were killed, including two chief of staff, when a VIP convoy was hit by a mine near the Mantain government office located in the Mandalay region.

PDFs fired mortar bombs at the SAC's camp located by the Industry 1 Textile factory, Salingyi township, Sagaing region.

Five SAC soldiers were killed and another two injured in a clash with PDFs in Pa Line village, Shwebo township, Sagaing region.

PDFs fired mortar bombs at an "army day" military parade in Nay Pyi Taw region.

Human Rights Violations

There was an air strike on Si Taung village and Man Wun by military forces in Shwegu township, Kachin state.

A 15-year-old boy was killed and a 50-year-old woman was injured when bomb shells exploded in the city's neighborhoods of Kawkareik township, Kayin state.

Six shops and one house was burned down by SAC forces in Mone Yway Sanpya village, Monywa township, Sagaing region.

One villager was killed and another two villagers were arrested by SAC troops in Gu Gyi Kone village, Sagaing township, Sagaing region.

Han Saw Tun, a member of the NLD party, was beaten and arrested by the junta's security forces in Katha township, Sagaing region.

Political and International Events

Nothing to report.

March 27, 2023

Strikes

Locals continue to boycott the SAC's 2023 elections and demonstrate for the end of the military regime. Places include Khin-U township and Yinmarbin-Salingyi township, Sagaing region; Pakokku township and Myaing township, Magway region; Hpakan township, Kachin state.

Election Updates

Zaw Min Tun, head of the press release group of the coup d'état group, said that the exact time of the election cannot be said yet, as he said during a meeting with reporters at the 78th Armed Forces Day ceremony held today, according to military aligned news sources.

Military Clashes

Two SAC soldiers were killed in a "Myananda Operation" vinyl mine attack near Yadanapam Hall on Daw Aung San Su Kyi road, in Mahaaungmyay township, Mandalay region.

18 SAC soldiers were killed in a mine attack organized by PDFs near Naung Lon Iron Bridge, Thabeikkyin township, Mandalay region.

Two SAC soldiers were killed and another four injured in a clash with PDFs by the SAC's camp at the city police station and Kak Kyaw Monastery, Yesagyo township, Magway region.

Six SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs in Tower Tie village, Okpho township, Bago region.

One police was injured in a clash between PDFs and SAC forces at the monastery in the SAC's camp in Yesagyo township, Magway region.

PDFs organized a mine attack on SAC troops in Falam township, Chin state.

Human Rights Violations

Two political prisoners were beaten up by the prison staff in Thayarwady prison.

Kon Taung Ywar Thit was entirely burned down by SAC troops in Tamu township, Sagaing region.

40 civilians were arrested by SAC troops from Sai Pyin village, Budalin township, Sagaing region.

Political and International Events

The junta coup leader Min Aung Hlaing gives a stern warning against ethnic armed groups supporting the opposition - the National Unity Government (NUG) and vows to punish those associated with NUG in a speech delivered today in commemoration of the 78th Anniversary of Tatmadaw Day in Myanmar.

Yangon Revolution Force - YRF announced that Min Aung Hlaing was decapitated and cursed with the help of experts on Revolution Day today. A YRF official said that Min Aung Hlaing's beheading was carried out in retribution for the people of Aya, who suffered much pain from the arresting, burning, and killing caused by the army.

March 28 2023

Strikes

Locals led demonstrations against the SAC's 2023 elections. Places include Pale-Gangaw road, Salingyi township, Latpataung Hill, Khin-U township, Wetlet township, and Myaung township in the Sagaing region.

Election Updates

UEC announced that 40 parties, including the NLD, were dissolved, and 63 parties were registered under the new law

Military Clashes

Three PDF soldiers were killed when the No. 5 Battalion of the KA and joint forces were able to seize the Base BP-11 of the SAC military in the east of Thanlwin.

The Karen National Liberation Army (KNLA) captured and burned the Maekhataw border military outpost in Karen state of southern Myanmar. About 50 SAC soldiers were killed and additionally weapons and ammunition were seized.

PDFs attacked the Nyaung Kone police station in Pyawbwe township, Mandalay region.

One SAC soldier was killed and another two injured by a mine attack organized by PDFs in the SAC's camp in Tower Tie village, Okapho township, Bago region.

Two members of the SAC's militias were killed and their guns seized during a clash with PDFs in Bokpyin township, Tanintharyi region.

PDFs fired mortar bombs in the SAC's camp in Bomin Kyimin village, Myinmu township, Sagaing region.

Human Rights Violations

Until the morning of March 28, there was no fighting in the Kawkareik township. However, the SAC began to fire heavy weapons into the villages where locals live, sending thousands fleeing the villages.

Families live along floating villages, digging gold from the second-largest river in the country. Military troops stormed the village today, burning most of the villagers' floating tents in Kabai village, Mingin township, Sagaing region.

A series of bomb blasts has rocked Shwebo town this morning as the bomb explosion has killed a civilian at the scene and wounded 20, including two young kids, of which 5 people are reported to have been critically injured.

The military council announced that 2 people who planned to fire shock missiles at the Revolutionary Day military parade were arrested. They were arrested from Zee Phyu Pin village, Pyin Ma Na township, Nay Pyi Taw region.

One child and a woman were killed when SAC troops fired mortar bombs at Sai Pyin town, Depaeyin township, Sagaing region.

Two civilians were killed and five injured when SAC forces fired mortar bombs in Mae Lay Yone village, Kyaikto township, Mon state.

Political and International Events

The National Unity and Peacemaking Coordination Committee (NSPNC) of the Military Council and the informal negotiation team of the 7 ceasefire groups held an informal meeting in Nay Pyi Taw on March 28.

March 29 2023

Strikes

Locals hold boycotts against the SAC's 2023 elections in Salingyi township and the north side of Yinmarbin in Sagaing region, and Myaing township, Magway region.

There were local boycotts against for the PTT to stop paying blood money to the Junta in the Yinmarbin-Salingyi township, Sagaing region.

The King Sakwatay strike committee organized a demonstration for the downfall of the military in Kyangin township, Ayeyarwady region.

Election Updates

The right to dissolve the officially formed National League for Democracy (NLD) party and political parties as an election commission in the hands of a terrorist group. The National League for Democracy issued a press release today saying that there is no approval at all.

Military Clashes

Six SAC soldiers were killed and three injured by a mine attack organized by PDFs on Mandalay-Mogoke road, Sa Kyin village, Mandaya township, Mandalay region.

Six SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with MINDAA forces in Kyinn Myawat village, Laukkaing township, North Shan state.

15 SAC soldiers were killed and one car damaged in a mine attack organized by PDFs in Ta Kaung town, Thabeikkyin township, Mandalay region.

Six SAC soldiers were killed by a drone attack orchestrated by PDFs at the Muppalin intersection checkpoint, Kyaikto township, Mon state.

Three SAC soldiers were killed and a helicopter was damaged when PDFs fired a mortar bomb in the Air Force Base Headquarters in Taungoo township, Bago region.

Five SAC soldiers were injured and one child was injured in a clash with PDFs in Ka Lane Awng town, Yebyu township, Tanintharyi region.

More than 40 SAC soldiers were killed when the Karen National Liberation Army attacked the junta outpost and captured it. The outpost, located in the Kayin state, was reported to have been burned as well.

According to the KNU's special force, 11 SAC soldiers were killed and another eight arrested during an offensive launched in the border town with Thailand in the Karen state of Myanmar (the economic zone of Myawaddy). Additionally, 17 assault rifles and ammunition were also seized.

Human Rights Violations

50 civilians were arrested by the SAC's forces in Mawlamyinegyun township, Ayeyarwady region.

One civilian was killed after hitting the military council's unexploded bomb in Thilin township.

14 villages of more than 1,000 residents from Salingyi township, Sagaing region fled when the army was deployed.

Four civilians were injured when the army bombed the area beside the evacuation camp in Demoso township, Kayah state.

Around 300 civilians fled when the whole Kin Pone Chine village was burned down in Salin township, Magway region.

Mr Kyi Hlah, the winner of a raffle fundraising ticket made for supporting local anti-junta resistance forces in Khin-U township, was arrested on March 26 after his winning ticket went viral on social media in northwest Myanmar.

One house was burned down when the army column entered into Nghaat Tought village and ransacked local houses and set them on fire in Ywar Ngan township, Taunggyi region. South Shan state.

Political and International Events

Nothing to report.

March 30 2023

Strikes

Locals continue to hold demonstrations against the SAC's 2023 elections in Kale and Taze township, Sagaing region and Myaing township, Magway region.

Civilians protest for international companies to sanction MOGE in Yinmarbin and Yinmarbin-Salingyi township, Sagaing region.

Election Updates

Nothing to report.

Military Clashes

The People's Knight Defense Force-MMU announced that the military vehicle leaving from Sagaing town to Myinmu was hit by 18 landmines, resulting in 13 soldiers being killed and many injured.

Four SAC soldiers were killed in a mine attack organized by PDFs between Kan Taw and Nyaung Gip Pin village, Pakokku township, Magway region.

There was a mine attack on SAC troops by PDFs in Gangaw township, Magway region.

Two SAC police were killed in a clash with PDFs between Gatone Paw and Tone Khala village, Thongwa township, Yangon region.

One SAC soldier was killed in a clash with PDFs in Salingyi township, Sagaing region.

Three SAC soldiers were killed in a mine attack organized by KIA forces on Nan Mon hill, Indaw Gyi region, Mohnyin township, Kachin state.

Human Rights Violations

The junta regime has bombed a Khuafu village - just a few miles away from Thantlang town, killing at least seven people: a Christian pastor, four children, and furthermore wounding dozens and destroying several houses in the Chin state.

Nyaung Pin Thar village was set on fire by SAC forces in Tigyaing township, Sagaing region.

One member of a PDF, the deputy battalion commander, was beheaded when the PDF camp in Myaung township, Sagaing region was raided by the military.

Six civilians were arrested by SAC forces in Aung Nant Thar Kone village, Indaw township, Sagaing region.

A group of youths gathering at night and enjoying drinks was arrested by the junta security forces last night in Yangon – the largest city in Myanmar.

Political and International Events

Nothing to report.

March 31 2023

Strikes

Locals continue to boycott the SAC's 2023 elections in Latpataung hill, the northside of Yinmarbin, and Yinmarbin-Salingyi township in the Sagaing region. Additionally boycotts took place in the Longlon township of Tanintharyi region.

Locals continue to boycott MOGE and call for sanctions in Yinmarbin township, Sagaing region.

Election Updates

The Military Council Election Commission announced that the bid for 10 items had been canceled.

Military Clashes

PDFs fired mortar bombs at the SAC militia camp in Bant Bwe village, Yinmarbin township, Sagaing region.

There was a clash between PDFs and SAC forces, including the police force, at the Nyaung Pin Win police station, Maung Htaung village, Sagaing township, Sagaing region.

There was a clash between PDFs and the SAC's forces at the district police outpost in Kan Sanpya village, Gangaw township, Magway region.

Two SAC soldiers were killed and 2 civilians were injured in a shooting at the Muse city car park in Muse township, North Shan state.

There was a drone attack on SAC forces by PDFs on Thin Kan Nyi Naung Bayuhar hill and the police station, Myawaddy township, Kayin state.

Two SAC soldiers were killed and another two soldiers and 1 SAC police member injured in a clash with PDFs in Gyo Pin Thar ward (3), Kani township, Sagaing region.

A man was killed and a child was arrested by SAC forces in Koe Taung Bho, Kanbalu township, Sagaing region.

There was an airstrike and burning on Si Mu Lay and Man Wain villages by SAC forces near Shwegu township, Kachin state.

Almost 30 civilians were arrested by SAC forces in No.1 Ward, Palaw township, Tanintharyi region.

One civilian was killed in an air strike fire organized by SAC forces on a school in Htee Pho Ka Lo village, Demoso township, Kayah state.

One child and two civilians were killed in the explosion of a bomb in Hti valley, Ah Lal taw village, Tigyaing township, Sagaing region.

There was an air strike organized by SAC forces on Kan village, the northside of Gangaw, Magway region.

Political and International Events

The military council removed the sign of the NLD party office in Ward 4, Kamaryut Township, Yangon Region.

NLD parliamentarian Daw Thet Dae was put in prison by military council on charges of terrorism in Myintkyina township, Kachin state.
