

Strikes

Locals hold boycotts against the SAC's 2023 elections in the following places: Launglon township, Tanintharyi region; Monywa township, Yinmarbin township, the northside of Yinmarbin, and Yinmarbin-Salingyi township in the Sagaing region.

Election Updates

Nothing to report.

Military Clashes

One soldier was killed by a remote controlled mine at the Sittaung Bridge checkpoint in Yedashe township, Bago region.

30 SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs in Tharzin village in Sataung town, Sagaing township, Sagaing region.

Two SAC soldiers were killed and another three injured in a clash with PDFs between Hnin Sone and Sanpya villages, Ye township, Mon State.

Three SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs at the SAC camp by the government technological college in Monywa township, Sagaing region.

Four SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs near Khin Palu village, Salin township, Magway region.

Human Rights Violations

The SAC military flew a fighter jet over Hpasawng township, Kayah (Karenni) State and fired three times sending residents fleeing overnight.

Two civilians were killed by SAC forces in Tilin township, Magway region.

Three civilians were arrested by SAC forces from Natogyi township, Mandalay region.

SAC forces burned down Ma Gyi Sought village in Ayadaw township, Sagaing region.

SAC forces launched an airstrike, dropping bombs on a war refugee camp in Moe Byel town, Pekon township, Shan (South) State.

More than 600 houses were burned down when SAC forces burned down Tharzin village in Sagaing township, Sagaing region.

Strikes

Military Clashes

Two PDF soldiers were killed, three were injured, and one was arrested when counter fighting took place with the SAC military's rearguard in Tilin township, Magway region.

About 30 SAC soldiers were killed when there was a three day battle that took place in the western part of Sataung, Sagaing township, Sagaing region.

Three SAC police soldiers were killed by a bomb attack organized by PDFs on the police station and SAC checpoint in Yenangyaung township, Magway region.

There was a clash between PDF and SAC forces at school and police station in SAC camps in Pan Thar village, Tamu township, Sagaing region.

27 SAC police soldiers and two PDF soldiers were killed in a clash between the two forces in Gaung Ei and Sat Tawillages in Pekon township, Shan (South) State.

There was a clash between PDFs and SAC forces in Khin-U township, Sagaing region.

Human Rights Violations

One civilian was killed by SAC forces in Na Nawin Kine village, Myaung township, Sagaing region.

Three civilians were arrested by SAC forces from Thingangyun township, Yangon region.

One child was killed and another two children were injured when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Thar Si village, Kale township, Sagaing region.

Three civilians were killed by SAC forces near Koe Pin villgae, Thabeikkyin township, Mandalay region.

Six houses were burned down by SAC forces in Thar Ga Ya village, Khin-U township, Sagaing region.

One civilian was killed when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Tha Khut Taw village, Wetlet township, Sagaing region.

Four houses were burned down by SAC forces in Shan Kone village in Kanbalu township, Sagaing reigon.

June 17, 2023

Strikes

Locals boyvcotted the SAC's 2023 elections in the following places: Yinmarbin township, the northside of Yinmarbin, and Yinmarbin township in the Sagaing region; Myaing township, Magway region; Kyangin township, Ayeyarwady region.

Military Clashes

Yesterday, in Kalaywah township of the Sagaing region, the People Defense Forces were able to seize a significant amount of weapons and ammunition from the junta army and its Pyu Saw Htee in addition to destroying two trucks of the junta army.

More than 10 SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs at the SAC's camp in Moe Byel town, Pekon township, Shan (South) State.

One SAC soldier and two SAC police soldiers were killed by a bomb attack organized by PDFs at the police station and SAC checkpoint in Yenangyaung township, Magway region.

More than four SAC soldiers were killed in a clahs wiht PDFs near Kyauk Man Kan bridge in Khin-U township, Sagaing region.

Three SAC police soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs at the No (2) police station in Monywa township, Sagaing region.

There was a clash betwee KIA forces and SAC forces near Nan San Yan village, Waingmaw township, Kachin State.

16 SAC soldiers were killed by a mine attack organized by PDFs between Ta Ohn and Ohn Pauk villages in Shwebo township, Sagaing region.

Human Rights Violations

The SAC military fired long-range missiles, targeting civilian homes and churches in Moe Byel town, Pekon township, Shan (South) State.

One civilian was killed when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Tha Khut Taw village, Wetlet township, Sagaing region.

SAC forces started fires near Nyang Pingyi beach and Marina in Salingyi township, Sagaing region.

One civilian was killed and one child and three civilians were injured when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Thein Zayet town, Ywar Lay ward, Kyaikto township, Mon State.

One civilian was killed when SAC froces fired mortar bombs at Kyauk Aie village in Ye township, Mon State.

Strikes

Military Clashes

One civilian was killed in a clahs between PDF and SAC forces near Pa Wet Kone village in Palaw township, Tanintharyi region.

There was a clash between PDFs and SAC roces between Ban Law and Thamee Hla village, Tanintharyi township, Tanintharyi region.

One SAC soldier was killed in a clash with PDFs at the SAC military gate in Mindat township, Chin State.

Human Rights Violations

Three civilians were arrested by SAC forces from Shwebo township, Sagaing region and Myothit, Magway region.

Six civilians were arrested by SAC forces from Sagaing township and Shwebo township in the Sagaing region.

One civilian was killed and another two injured when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Chaung Hna Khwa village in Thandaunggyi township, Kayin State.

SAC forces burned down villages in Wetlet township, Sagaing region.

Three civilians were arrested by SAC forces from Chanmyathazan and Chanayethazan Township, Mandalay region.

Strikes

Locals held protests against the SAC's 2023 elections in the following places: Yinmarbin-Salingyi township, Yinmarbin township, and Latpataung hill in the Sagaing region; Launglon township, Tanintharyi region.

Military Clashes

Four SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs in Pakokku and Myaing township, Magway region.

There was a clash between PDFs and SAC forces in Moe Byel Town, Pekon township, Shan (South) State.

Two SAC soldiers were killed in a clash wiht PDFs at the SAC's camp in Han Lin old town in Wetlet township, Sagaing region.

Eight SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs at the SAC's camp in Dawei township, Tanintharyi region.

Human Rights Violations

One person from Hto Mar village was killed and another injured when SAC troops fired bullets in Kale township, Sagaing region.

12 Civilians were arrested by SAC forces from Sintgaing township, Mandalay region.

180 Houses were burned down when SAC forces burned down Phaya Pyan village in Wetlet township, Sagaing region.

Eight civilians were arrested by SAC forces from Nan Baw Wan Ward, Loikaw township, Kayah (Karenni) State.

Strikes

Locals boycott the SAC's 2023 elections in Monywa township, Yinmarbin-Salingyi township, Latpataung hill, and Kani township in the Sagaing region.

Election Updates

Military Clashes

Three SAC policemen were killed by PDFs while patrolling in Kani township, Sagaing region.

Almost 10 SAC soldiers were killed in a clash between PDFs and SAC forces at Ta Lin Gyi port, Myingyan township, Mandalay reigon.

Eight SAC police soldiers were killed by a bomb attack organized by PDFs at the palace in Shwebo township, Sagaing region.

There was a clash between PDFs and SAC forces in Hpaswang township, Kayah (Karenni) State.

There was a drone attack on SAC forces organized by PDFs at the Kin Mon Chaung police station, Kyaikto township, Mon state.

Two SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs in King Pyit village, Khin-U township, Sagaing region.

Human Rights Violations

The father of a Dawei District Strike leader was beaten and arrested by SAC's Forces from Pyin Htain village, Launglon township, Tanintharyi region.

Strikes

Locals boycotted the SAC's 2023 elections in the following places: Yinmarbin-Salingyi township, the northside of Yinmarbin, Yinmarbin township, and Salingyi township in the Sagaing region; Launglon township, Tanintharyi region.

Election Updates

Military Clashes

More than 40 SAC soldiers, including three officers, were killed when PDFs launched a drone attack, dropping more than nine bombs on SAC troops in Kyauk Sit Pone village, Monywa township, Sagaing reigon.

Two SAC soldiers were shot and killed by snipers in Kyet Pyin village, Madaya township, Mandalay region.

Four SAC militia soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs between Sin In and Myin Sie villages, Shwebo township, Sagaing region.

Five SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs near Thamee Hla village, Tanintharyi township, Tanintharyi region.

Two SAC soldiers were killed and another three injured by a drone attack organized by PDFs at the electrical office in Kyone Doe town, Kawkareik township, Kayin State.

17 SAC soldiers were killed by a drone attack organized by PDFs at the SAC's camp in Ngwe Twin village, Ayadaw township, Sagaing region.

Human Rights Violations

One civilian was killed when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Ye Paw village in Tanintharyi township, Tanintharyi region.

Two civilians were arrested by SAC forces from Kan Pauk Area, Yebyu township, Tanintharyi region.

One civilian was killed by SAC forces in Seikphyu township, Mandalay region.

20 Civilians were arrested by SAC forces from Pyay township, Bago region.

Three civilians were killed and more than seven were injured when the KIA administrative office in Hapakan township, Kachin State was raided.
