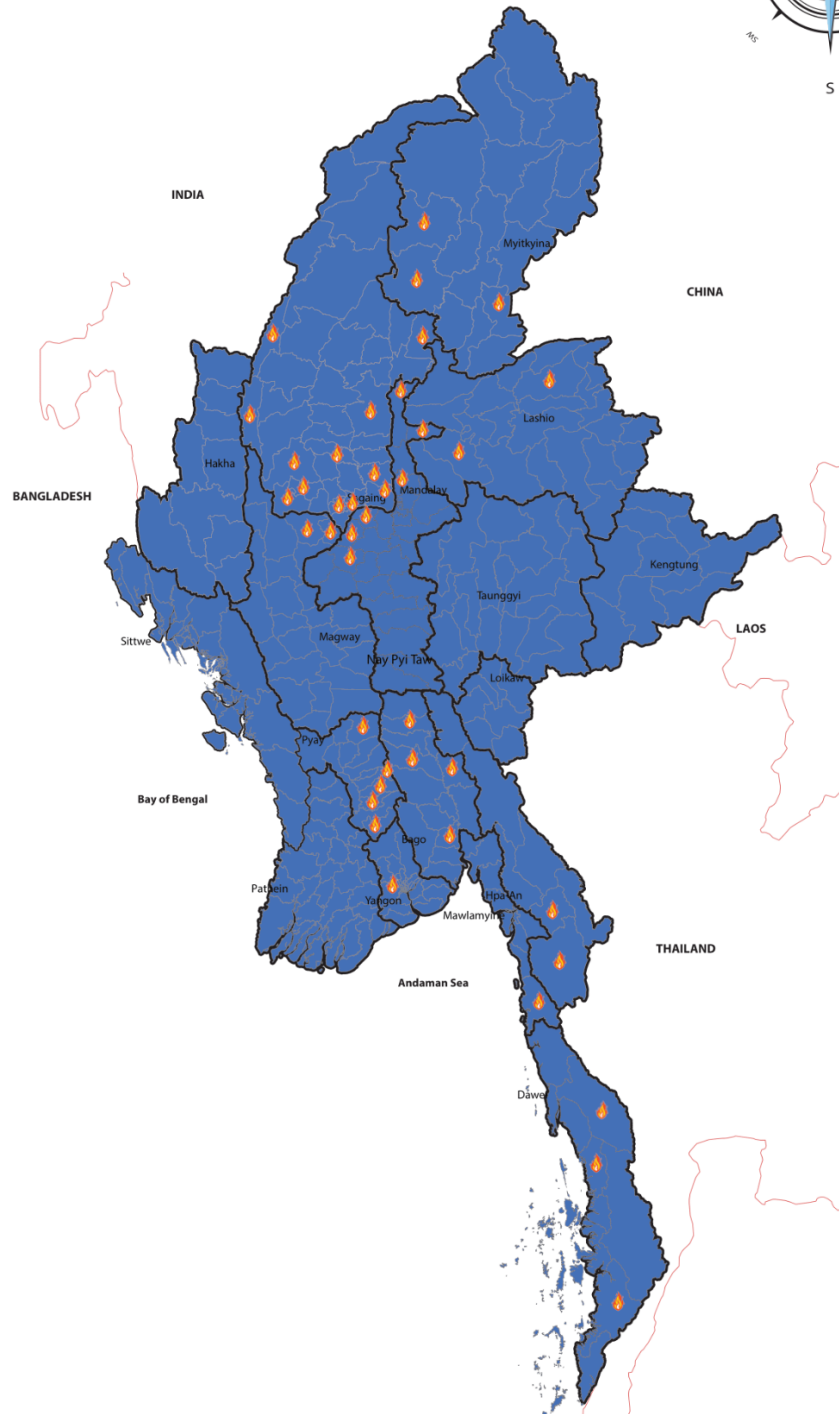
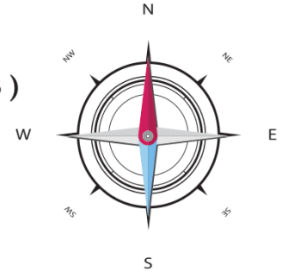

Locals held boycotts against the SAC's 2023 elections in the following places:
Yinmarbin-Salingyi township, Lapataung Hill area, and Yinmarbin Township in Sagaing.

Election Updates

Nothing to report.

Military Clashes

Six SAC soldiers were killed in a drone attack organized by PDFs at Pa Win Tap village, Wetlet township, Sagaing region.

Two SAC soldiers were killed in a shooting attack at the Phaya Mae checkpoint on the outskirts of Dawei township, Tanintharyi region.

Three SAC soldiers were killed and many more injured during a four day battle in Wetlet township, Sagaing region.

There was a clash between KIA and SAC forces near Kone Law village, Momauk township, Kachin State.

Two SAC soldiers, including a captain, were killed when a MOGE oil police outpost was attacked in Gangaw township, Magway region.

Eight SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs near Kyun Chaung village, Seikphyu township, Magway region.

There was a clash between PDF and SAC forces in Demoso township, Kayah (Karenni) State.

Human Rights Violations

The Military Council launched an air bombardment on the Song Phawe refugee camp in Pekon township, Shan (South) State.

26 Houses were burned down by SAC forces in Sin Wine village, Nattalin township, Bago region.

Political and International Events

Nothing to report.

September 9, 2023

Strikes

Locals boycott the SAC's elections in Yinmarbin-Salingyi township, Yinmarbin township, and Lapataung Hill Area in Sagaing region.

Election Updates

Nothing to report.

Military Clashes

13 SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs between Htone Bo Kone and Shar Kae villages, Wetlet township, Sagaing region.

Eight SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs between Kyint Pyin and Ywar Thar Kone villages, Seikphyu township, Sagaing region.

20 SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with KIA forces near Aung Jar village, Laiza town, Moemauk township, Kachin State.

3 SAC soldiers were killed, including a captain, in a heavy weapon attack on the SAC's Khalara Battalion-61 in Ye township, Mon State.

Seven SAC soldiers, including a lieutenant, were killed in an attack on a MOGE police outpost in Gangaw township, Magway region.

27 SAC soldiers were killed in two landmine attacks on an army column near Sa Mu Pyin village, Palaw township, Tanintharyi region.

There was a clash between TNLA and SAC forces in Kyaukme township, northern Shan State.

Human Rights Violations

One civilian was killed and one child and four civilians were injured when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Lett Ku Village, Palaw township, Tanintharyi region.

Two civilians were killed by SAC forces at Lal Ainn Gyi village, Kanbalu township, Sagaing region.

One civilian was set on fire and 11 houses were burned down by SAC forces in Pho Win Tap village, Wetlet township, Sagaing region.

Three children and one civilian were killed and another seven injured when SAC fighter jets fired at a school in Htee Gaw Htar village in Hpapun township, Kayin State.

September 10, 2023

Strikes

Locals boycott the SAC's 2023 elections in the following places: Salingyi township, Yinmarbin township, Ayadaw township, the northside of Yinmarbin township and Lapataung Hill Area in the Sagaing region.

Election Updates

Military Clashes

Two SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs in Let Pan village, Waw township, Bago region.

Two SAC soldiers were killed and another three injured in a clash with PDFs at the SAC camp at the general administration office in Yesagyoo township, Magway region.

Two SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs at Nant Phat Kar village, Kutkai township, northern Shan State.

Seven SAC soldiers were killed in a drone attack organized by PDFs to the north of Pukkan station, Wetlet township, Sagaing region.

Two SAC soldiers were killed in a mine attack organized by PDFs on SAC forces between Ohn Taw and Ywar Thit villages, Sagaing township, Sagaing region.

Seven SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs near Kyaw Zaya village, Sagaing township, Sagaing region.

Eight SAC soldiers were killed and another eight injured in a clash with PDFs at Hpapun township, Kayin State.

Seven SAC soldiers were killed in a drone attack organized by PDFs near Khaung Po village, Nganzun township, Mandalay region.

Five SAC police officers were killed when Kan Kyin police station was raided by PDFs in Paukhaung township, Bago region.

There was a clash between PDF and SAC forces at the SAC's Khar Chin Taung Forest Gate in Minhla township, Bago region.

Human Rights Violations

Two teachers were injured when the army fired heavy weapons at the city of Dongphonyang in Momauk township, Kachin State.

One civilian was killed and another eight civilians were arrested by SAC forces from Kan Gyi Yoe village, Myaing township, Magway region.

One civilian and one child was killed when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Lay Eain Su village, Phyu township, Bago region.

23 Houses were burned down by SAC forces in Mway Pon Kan Taung village, Madaya township, Mandalay region.

One civilian was killed by SAC forces in Ta Kha Mate village, Tamu township, Sagaing region.

Political and International Events

The Burma National Revolutionary Army was not formed separately, but was formed under the NUG government so that it could stand firmly on the side of the public, said Colonel Nagar.

The Military Council stated that Russia and Myanmar will sign treaties with one another.

The Military Council forces arrested five directors, including the Director General of the Ministry of Economy and Commerce of the Military Council.

September 11, 2023

Strikes

Locals boycott the SAC's 2023 election in the following places: Yimarbin-Salingyi township, Lapataung Hill area, Salingyi township, and Yinmarbin township in Sagaing; Kyangin township, Ayeyarwaddy region.

Election Updates

Nothing to report.

Military Clashes

3 SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs between Kone village and Nyaung Pin Eai village, Gyobingauk township, Bago region.

There was a battle between SAC and KIA forces in Hawng Par village in Hapakan township, Kachin State. SAC troops forced civilians to leave the area.

Four military vehicles were intercepted and destroyed by KIA forces when they were traveling as a convoy in Daw Phon Yang town, Momauk township, Kachin State.

15 SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs at the SAC Sate Phue Taung camp in Taungoo township, Bago region.

Four SAC soldiers were killed in a mine attack organized by PDFs near the east side of the Joe Jar Eu village, Pale township, Sagaing region.

Five SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs between Nwae Shaught village and Kyawann Bho Kone village, Pale township, Sagaing region.

25 SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs near Shwe Taung (old) village, Yedashe township, Bago region.

Five SAC soldiers were killed in a mine attack organized by PDFs between Htain Pan and Ma Gyi Su villages, Myingyan township, Mandalay region.

There was a clash between PDF and SAC forces at Mya Daung village, Palaw township, Tanintharyi region.

Human Rights Violations

The SAC arrested the father of (Ko) Kyaw Ko Ko, the former chairperson of the Ba-Ka-Tha in Tamwe township, Yangon region.

Two civilians were arrested by SAC forces from Sate Thar village, Madaya township, Mandalay region.

One civilian was injured by a military helicopter that shot at a refugee school in Yinmarbin township, Sagaing region.

Political and International Events

Nothing to report.

September 12, 2023

Strikes

Locals protested against the SAC's 2023 elections in the following places: Yinmarbin-Salingyi township, Yimarbin township, Lapataung Hill Area, and the northside of Yinmarbin in the Sagaing region; Launglon township, Tanintharyi region. They were protesting with the slogan "Our Ambassador - Our Voice".

Election Updates

Nothing to report.

Military Clashes

Two SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs near Maung Mal Shaung village, Dawei township, Tanintharyi region.

One PDF soldier was killed and a civilian was killed and another four injured in a clash with SAC forces near Pi Tap village, Palaw township, Tanintharyi region.

There was a clash between Kia and SAC forces near Madi Yan village, Momauk township, Kachin State.

Human Rights Violations

More than 60 civilians were arrested by SAC forces from Nganzun township, Mandalay region.

A CDM health staff and a stroke patient in Tamu township were killed by gun shots fired by the SAC in Kha Mate village, Tamu township, Sagaing region.

One civilian was killed by SAC forces near Nyaung Nyo Taw village, Myaing township, Magway region.

Three civilians were killed by SAC forces in Thone Sal town, Tharrawaddy township, Bago region.

10 Civilians were arrested by SAC forces from Hpakan township, Kachin State.

Political and International Events

U Kyaw Zaw, spokesperson of the presidential office, said that the Military Council did not consult with the NUG on the formation of the new army led by Captain Nagar.

The KNLA appoints new brigade commanders and strategists.

From 40 villages in Taze township, Sagaing region, the PaAhPha, Palapa and Pakafa held a meeting for the first time.

September 13, 2023

Strikes

Locals protested against the SAC's 2023 elections in the following places: the northside of Yinmarbin, Yinmarbin-Salinyi township, Lapataung Hill Area, and Taze township in the Sagaing region; Myaing township, Magway region. They protested using the slogan "Our Ambassador - Our Voice".

Election Updates

Nothing to report.

Military Clashes

One SAC police officer was killed by PDFs at the SAC checkpoint near Tagaung town, Thabeikkyin township, Mandalay region.

Two SAC soldiers were killed when the military column that looted public property was intercelted near Ingyin Su village, Pale township, Sagaing region.

There was a clash between PDF and SAC forces in No (3) ward in Kani township, Sagaing region.

Three SAC soldiers were killed and another seven injured when PDFs fired mortar bombs at KhaMaYa 583 and KhaMaYa 591 in Ye township, Mon State.

Human Rights Violations

Prison authorities agreed to the demands of political prisoners on hunger strike in Monywa prison in Monywa township, Sagaing region.

One civilian was injured when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Mi Chaung Gaung village, Mone town, Kyaukkyi township, Bago region.

Political and International Events

September 14, 2023

Strikes

Locals protested against the SAC's 2023 elections in Salingyi township, Yinmarbin township, Lapataung Hill Area, and Yinmarbin-Salingyi township in the Sagaing region. They protested using the slogan "Our Ambassador - Our Voice".

Election Updates

Military Clashes

Three SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs in Kani township, Sagaing region.

There was a clash between KIA and SAC forces near Mine Naung village, Mohnyin township, Kachin State.

Two SAC soldiers were killed and another six injured in a clash with PDFs at the SAC's Pin Laung Kone San Camp near Mogoke township, Mandalay region.

Four SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs at the SAC camp in Tabayin township, Sagaing region.

Three SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs at the SAC's camp in Chaung-U township, Sagaing region.

Four SAC soldiers were injured in a clash with PDFs at Yesagyio township, Magway region.

Human Rights Violations

Three civilians were arrested by SAC forces from Taungtha township, Mandalay region.

Three students were injured when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Shar Pho village, Kale township, Sagaing region.

Political and International Events

A meeting between all the Air Force Chiefs in ASEAN was held in Nay Pyi Taw.

The Foreign Minister of the Military Council met with the Russian Foreign Minister in Russia.

Russia agreed to help the Military Council with their election.
